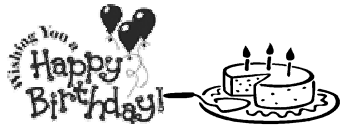
Quilters. The Quilters will start back meeting this Tuesday, December 1st at 10:00 a.m.

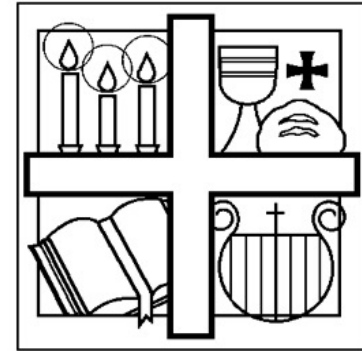
