Youth Meeting. The Youth will meet Sunday night at 5:30 p.m. and Wednesday night at 6:15 p.m.

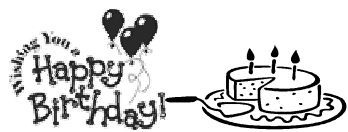

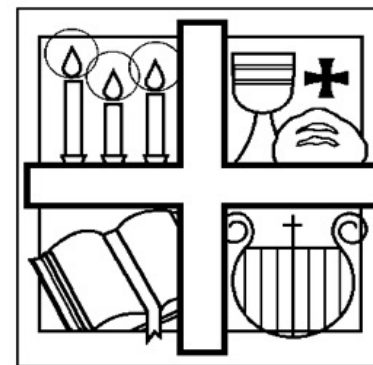
